Sabbatical House Listing Guidelines

1. Each listing must be submitted in writing by homeowner, including subsequent listings of the same facility.
2. All negotiations are between homeowner and renter.
3. Only completely furnished houses may be listed.

We do **not** list:

- a) apartments, private rooms, or shared homes
- b) private properties with two or more rentals [*rule verified 5/4/11*]

Separate private apartments attached to a home will be listed only after inspection by the sabbatical house chair(s).

4. All houses must be in move-in condition (see separate email attachment for specifics).
5. A home may be listed as “home for exchange.”
6. The home address must be listed [*rule added 11/21/1992*].
7. Cottages on private property must be approved by sabbatical house chairs and must have a separate mailing address [*rule added 2/14/11*].
8. Sublets may be listed only with written permission of owner.
9. If homeowners use a manager or realtor to handle their property, only the first name and the personal telephone number of this person will be listed.
10. Any listing may be denied or cancelled at the discretion of the sabbatical chairs [*rule added 3/29/1995, updated 2/15/2013*].

Fees: The fee for each rental is \$75. We list no more than six months in advance. Ads may run for a maximum of six months. Re-listing a house or listing a home for exchange requires the same fee. Checks should be payable to University Farm Circle.

Success: Please notify us once your house has been rented, in order that we make keep our listings up to date, as well as save you further inquiries.
